ABOUT THE FLORENCE COPPER 'CREATING OPPORTUNITIES' SCHOLARSHIP

Florence Copper is proud to be in its 12th year of the Creating Opportunities scholarship program. Since the program was established in 2011, Florence Copper has awarded over \$69,000 in scholarships to talented students in Florence and surrounding communities to help them pursue higher education.

Florence Copper is committed to this community and to helping young people achieve success.

This year, up to \$5,000 in one-time scholarships will be awarded to high school seniors who live in Florence and/or attend school in the Florence Unified School District. Individual scholarships will range from \$500 to \$2500 per student.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must live in Florence and/or attend school in the Florence Unified School District boundaries.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Scholarships will be judged and awarded based on the following criteria:

- Academic, athletic, or other achievement (community, volunteer, etc.)
- Leadership capabilities
- Achievements, awards, and recognition at school, in the community, and/or personal activities
- Creativity and quality of video submission

Awards will be made without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, disability, or other protected classifications.

HOW TO APPLY?

Complete this form and your video by **May 2, 2022 and** submit to Florence Copper.

Florence Copper is an in-situ copper recovery facility located in Florence, Arizona. Currently, Florence Copper is completing work for its test facility and advancing in the permitting process for commercial operations. More information about Florence Copper can be found at florencecopper.com.

The Fun Part.

As part of the application process, we are asking students to record and edit a two-minute video (or shorter) answering the question: ***What role will copper play in America's transition to clean energy?***

We encourage you to be creative. Act a play, sing a song, recite a poem, or anything else. The more creative the video the better. No fancy equipment is necessary. Cell phone recordings are fine. We are looking for videos that are creative and educate an audience about how copper has many uses in emerging technology and will be important in the future for green economy solutions.

Basic editing can be done with programs such as iMovie (for MAC users) or Windows Video Editor (for PC users). There are also ways to edit from smart phones using apps. Still photography options used in these programs will be accepted with sound effects (voice narrative, sounds or music added). Tutorials for how to use these programs can be found online. Final submission must be in a supported YouTube file format. Any music must meet YouTube's copyright guidelines.

Proof of full-time enrollment may be required.

Checks will be made payable to the student upon enrollment confirmation at the qualified institution.
