ABOUT THE FLORENCE COPPER CREATING OPPORTUNITIES SCHOLARSHIP

Florence Copper Inc. is proud to be in its 5th year of the Creating Opportunities Scholarship Program. Since the program was established in 2011, Florence Copper has awarded over \$52,000 in scholarships to talented students in the Florence Unified School District to help them pursue a higher education.

Florence Copper Inc. is committed to this community and to helping young people achieve success in their education, and we believe strongly in supporting academic success.

This year, four \$1,000 one-time scholarships will be awarded to high school seniors in the Florence Unified School District (\$4,000 in total). Students will be selected from Florence High School and Poston Butte High School.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be enrolled at either Florence High School or Poston Butte High School, in the Florence Unified School District.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Scholarships will be judged and awarded based on the following criteria:

- Academic, athletic, or other achievement (community, volunteer, etc.)
- Leadership capabilities
- Achievements, awards and recognition at school, in the community and/or personal activities
- Creativity and quality of video submission and application essay
- Letter(s) of recommendation

Awards will be made without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, disability or other protected classifications.

HOW TO APPLY?

Complete this form, essay and video by **April 29, 2015** and submit to Florence Copper.

THE ESSAY.

As part of the application process, we require a short essay of 500 words or less on ***how copper impacts your lifestyle.***

THE FUN PART.

Florence Copper Inc. is a proposed in-situ copper recovery facility located in Florence, Arizona. We are in the advanced permitting stages for a Production Test Facility. More information about the Florence Copper Project is available at www.florencecopper.com.

As part of the application process, we are asking students to record and edit a two minute video on ***how copper plays a role in your everyday life.***

We encourage you to be creative. Act a play, sing a song, recite a poem, or anything else. The more creative the video the better. No fancy equipment is necessary. Cell phone recordings are just fine. We are looking for videos that are creative and also educate an audience about how copper has many uses in our society and is important to modern lifestyles.

Basic editing can be done with programs such as iMovie (for MAC users) or Windows Live Movie Maker (for PC users). Still photography options used in these programs will be accepted with sound effects (voice narrative, sounds or music added). Tutorials for how to use these programs can be found online. Final submission must be in a supported YouTube file format.

SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

All applications shall be reviewed by a committee comprised of Florence Copper Inc. staff members and advisors.

Recipients will be notified by mail no later than May 5, 2015 and the scholarship will be presented to them at their high school's senior awards program in May.

RECIPIENT REQUIREMENTS

The recipient must enroll as a full-time student at a qualified institution for the academic year the award is granted.

INSTITUTION CRITERIA

Scholarships will only be awarded for full-time enrollment at an accredited two or four-year college, university, business or trade school based in the United States (no correspondence schools accepted). The institution must be accredited by appropriate government, state or education agencies.

Proof of full-time enrollment will be required.

OTHER

Checks will be made payable to the student upon enrollment confirmation at the qualified institution.
